Dallas is also the first major city in the nation to have its own stand-alone, comprehensive website, *GreenDallas.net*, which is dedicated solely to environmental issues and stewardship.

In the coming issues of *Edible Dallas & Fort Worth*, I hope you will enjoy all that our city has to offer in terms of fresh produce, a thriving population and vibrant culture. Welcome to Dallas!
